ALEF

It is hard to believe that the LBSY school year will be ending soon! The students are demonstrating a good understanding of Hebrew, and we continue to add to both the letters learned and vocabulary. Today we learned the Hebrew letter, *hey*, and briefly talked about Havdalah. Please continue to practice flashcards and do the Hebrew review sheet sent home at least three times.

We continued discussing Shavuot, one of our most important holidays, as we did not get very far in the lesson last week. Time permitting, we also discussed Yom Ha'atzmaut.

Next week, we will be learning the letter *resh* and studying the importance of prayer and blessings, and starting our study of Purim.

Hopefully, starting next week, the weather will improve and we can do some educational games outside, so please be sure your student has a jacket.

BET

This week, we learned the letter hey, and some Hebrew words to go along with it. As with last week, please complete the Hebrew practice and bring it back next week.

We also did our filming for our Purim Puppet Show! Everyone in the class showed such creativity in this project, I cannot wait for you to see it. It will be shown on Wednesday, March 20th, at the AJ program. I will have so much fun editing this week. :)

We also talked about parts about Judaism that we like to learn the most about, and what we want to focus the rest of the year on. In April, I'm going to base my curriculum around what the students want to be learning, so I'm excited for an eclectic mix of topics.

I will not be in class for the next two weeks, as I will be out of town. There will be a substitute teacher instead. As usual, feel free to email me or text me with any questions.

We have been continuing our study of the V'ahavta and preparing our artwork for the Megillah reading at Purim. More updates next week!

We have been working so diligently on our Purim projects. Tissue paper was everywhere! Over the next couple of weeks, we will continue to enjoy Purim as we make hamantaschen in class, make mishloach manot, play games testing our courage, and delve into the megillah further.

HEY

This week we discussed the Jewish wedding ceremony. Some themes were the ketubah (contract), bedeken, (veiling) and chupah (canopy). Students designed and worded their own ketubahs. They also finished their projects and presented them to the class. We also took some time out to look at chapter 5 of the Megillah. We will continue to look at Purim and the Megillah as well as make and decorate a chupah.

We are still working on v'ahavta in Hebrew and the students are making good strides in learning it. Please have them practice at home if possible
